harmony.

To inculcate life skills among both the genders leading to gender equity,

mutual understanding, responsible and sensible behavioural pattern,

leadership among the women;

• To foster core competencies to empower and mainstreaming the women

so as to enhance their contribution to national development;

• To strengthen the collaborations with GOs, NGOs working for the women

cause by way of conducting joint training/orientation programmes,

seminars, workshops through collaborative arrangements.
