Ramps & Railing facility

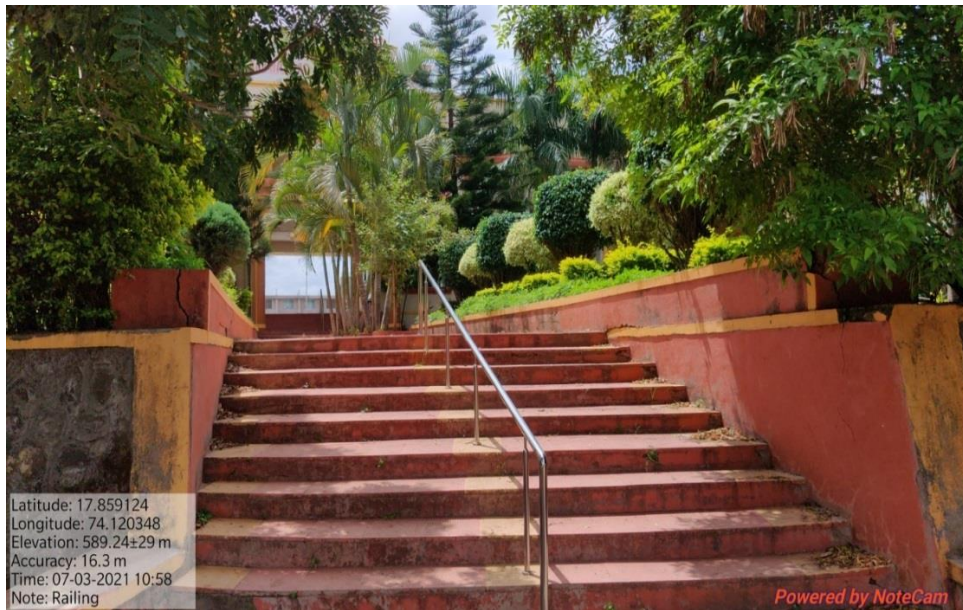
The Ramps are built through the campus where uneven floor levels or kerbs are present to provide convenience and prevent tripping accidents. Ramps are helpful to push a pallet truck, trolley, or wheel chair over a kerb or step by negotiating just a few inches of height difference. Utility ramps solve the problem and make wheeled movement between uneven levels very easy. The following ramps were built in college campuses for continence and safety of disabled persons (Divyangjan) shown in figure 1to4.

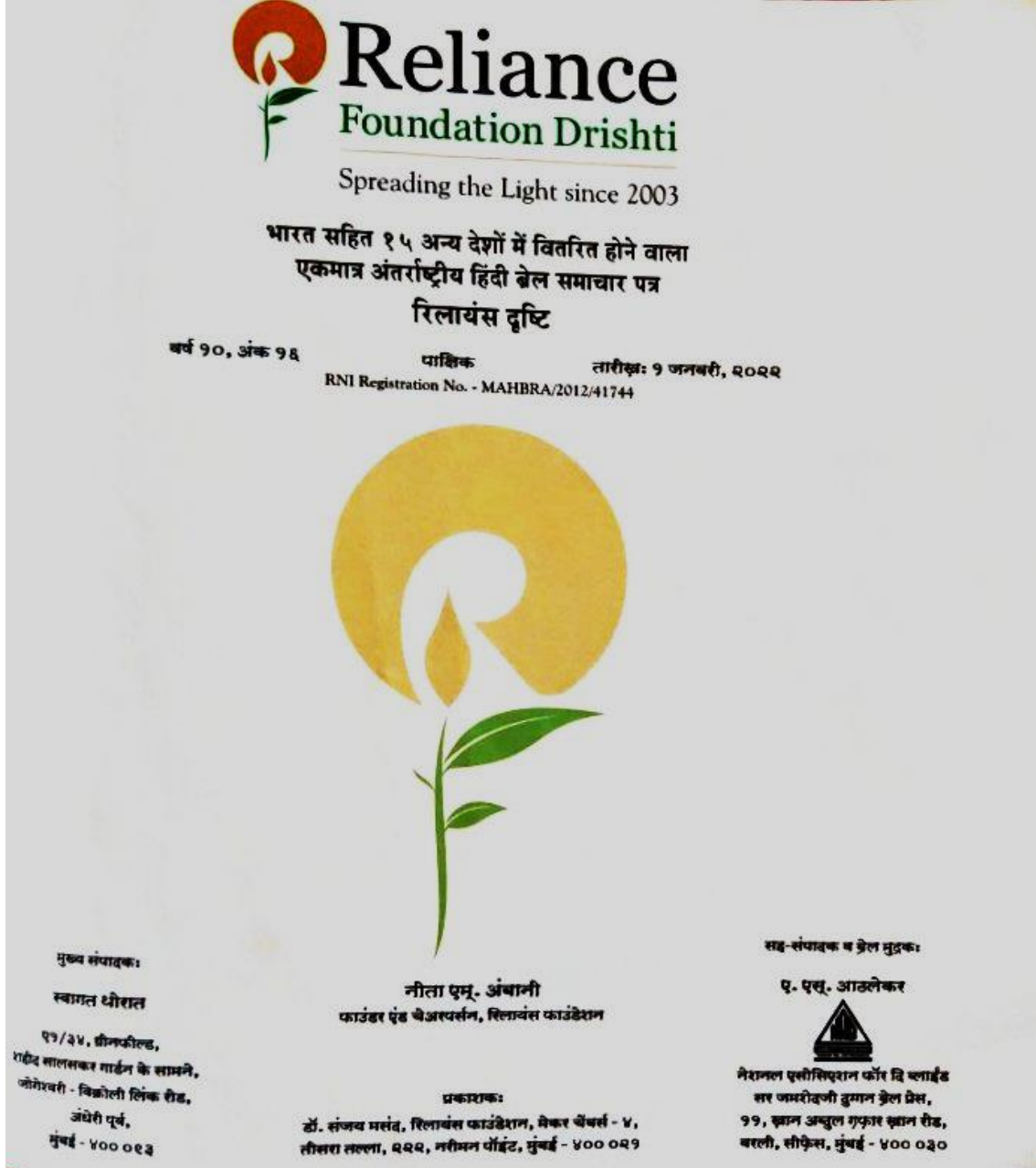

Subscription of Braille Magazine:

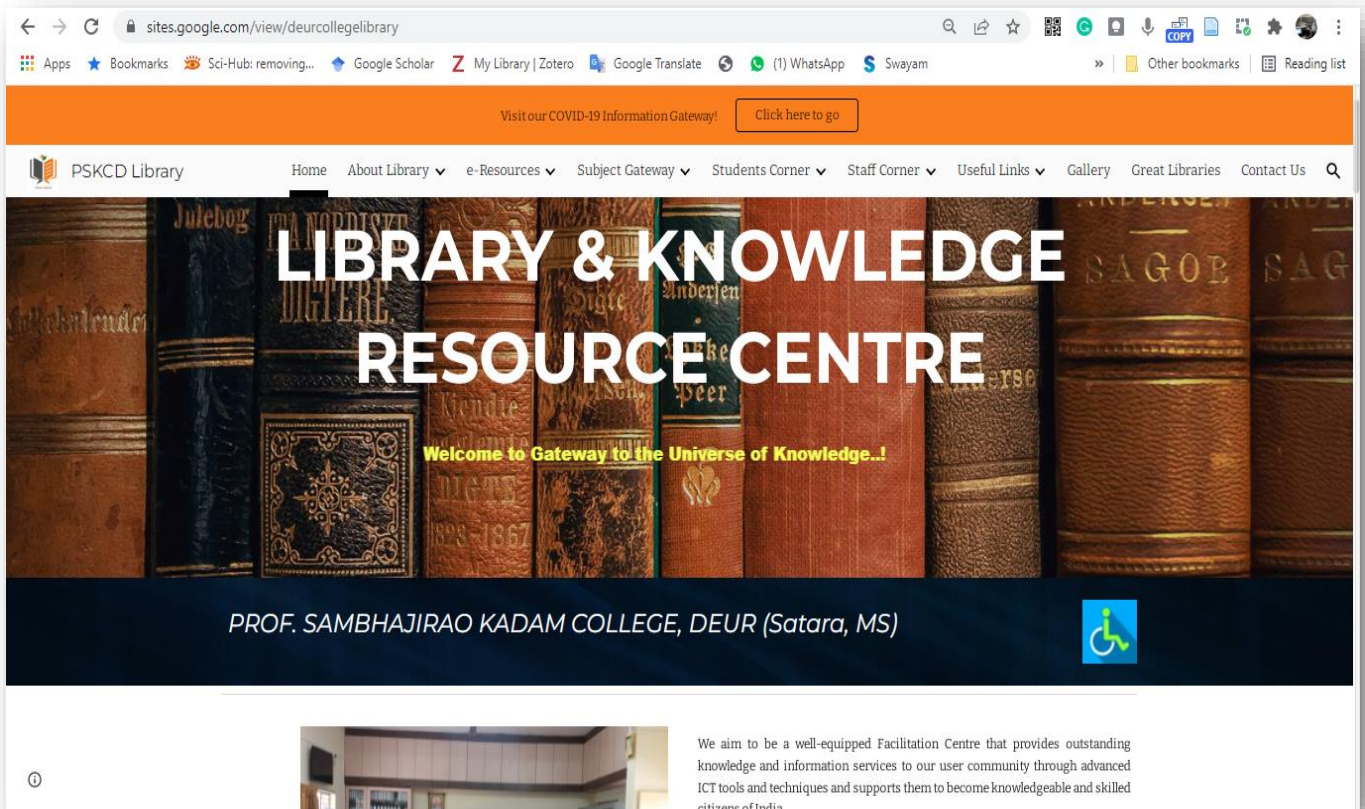


