### Prof. Sambhajirao Kadam College, Deur (Satara) Feedback Action Taken Report (2022-23)

IQAC receives periodic feedback from Students, Parents, Employers and Alumni on Teacher Performance, Curriculum (Course) and the Overall Performance of the Institution. This Feedback Mechanism is structured on a Five-point Scale: Excellent, Very Good, Good, Average and Poor. The Feedbacks are received through the dynamic web portal of the HEI <a href="https://pskcollegedeur.ac.in/feedback-forms/">https://pskcollegedeur.ac.in/feedback-forms/</a> and placed before the IQAC for further action.

IQAC, through its subcommittees framed under the Quality Indicators, analyze the reports and imparts suggestions for improvement. The Committee received following suggestions from students/Employers/Alumni/Parents and placed it before the IQAC:

- 6) There was a demand for internship/OJT/Experimental Learning activities for students.

IQAC, based on the inputs given by the Feedback Committee in AY 2022-23, came up with the following suggestions/recommendation and submitted it to the Principal for further action.

### **Action Taken:**

The Principal called meeting of the Faculty Members and apprised them regarding the overall Feedback from the stakeholders, its analysis and IQAC recommendations. He admired the performance of those teachers who secured good scores in respective Feedbacks and communicated his valuable suggestions for those who need improvement.
